Scholars interned or obtained full-time job offers

at a range of companies and organizations, including Bloomberg, Bleacher Report, the Fulbright Program, Open Society Foundations, Obama Foundation, JetBlue, GE, IBM, BlackRock, Citibank, and S&P.

Students also pursued educational and professional opportunities in Brazil, Greece, China, Costa Rica, Egypt, Morocco, Iceland, and Spain.

For the third consecutive summer, rising first-year college Scholars who are interested in pursuing STEM

majors participated in Summer Bridge Programming. We were thrilled to send six female SEO College Scholars to participate in the intensive Meyerhoff Summer Bridge Accelerator at University of Maryland Baltimore County. Additionally, five Scholars participated in STEM



programming at Baruch College.

Each program provided early exposure to and the guidance to overcoming the rigors of college STEM.

Career Summit:

In May, SEO Career hosted more than 300 college sophomores and juniors at its annual, week-long SEO Career Summit in New York City. The Career Summit featured 50 guest speakers, 32 training classes, and 12 special events. This was a monumental kick-off to our interns' summer internships. The SEO Career Intern Class of 2019 left feeling more prepared and confident, professionally trained, and fully equipped with key advice from c-suite executives.



Edge Summit:

In June and July, SEO Career hosted two SEO Career EDGE Summits, where more than 300 students collectively spent their Saturdays receiving career development tips, networking with corporate recruiters and executives, and receiving the insight they need to be successful interns.
